Reporting to the Energy and Climate Action Program Manager, this position provides technical support and acts as a subject matter expert in both community and corporate climate action matters. The successful candidate will work closely with the development and construction industry with a goal to achieve enhanced compliance for energy aspects of the B.C. Building Code and to maximize sustainability in new construction. Priorities include establishing building energy related policies, goals and objectives that would enable significant and lasting reductions in community and corporate energy use, greenhouse gas emissions as well as implementation of building energy related guidelines in various Neighbourhood Plans through the Development Permit process.
